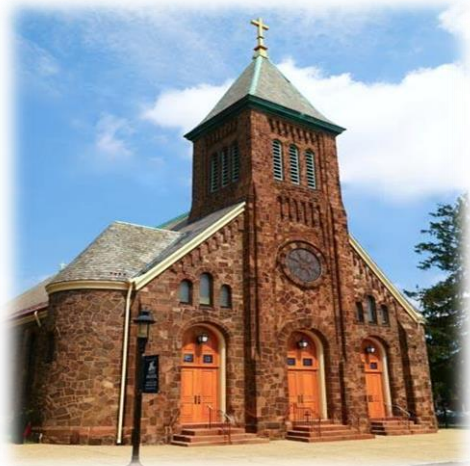
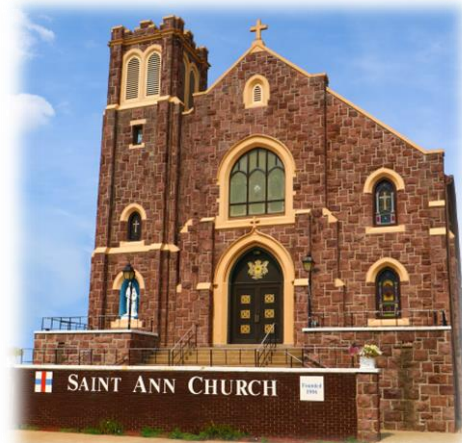

Twenty- First Sunday in Ordinary Time



My Dear Friends,

Our Gospel today contains one of the most important Church declarations and St. Peter's profession of Jesus. In St. Peter's Basilica in Rome inscribed around the dome above the altar are the words in Latin: "*You are Peter, and upon this rock I will build my church.*" Also, found under the altar are the bones of St. Peter. In an article from the magazine, "*The Priest*", Father Richard DeLillio, OSFS, writes; "...Peter's profession of Jesus as the Christ, and Jesus' confirmation of Peter as the rock upon which he, the Lord, will build the Church. Jesus then gives the keys to his kingdom designating this apostle as the keeper of the keys of the kingdom that Jesus is to establish. In this Gospel, Peter gives a full profession of faith, only possible by special revelation of God. It is truly a post-resurrection understanding of Jesus' lordship and unique filial relationship to the Father, given to Peter and all the disciples by the Risen Christ. This recognition of Jesus was not possible by human insight alone, but with much goodwill and integrity, matched by an ardent desire for unity, the will of Christ for a Church where "*all may be one*" can become a reality. The question to Peter by Jesus, "*But who do you say that I am?*" This is a question that Jesus asks of us today, "*Who do you say that I am?*" We have answers that were taught but in our prayers to the Father we find a deeper understanding and knowledge of Jesus the Christ.

This was a busy week with our St. Ann Italian Carnival, and I thank all who gave their time, and sacrifice to make our Carnival such a success. Next week's bulletin will give a detailed report for you.

Our Principal Mrs. Maria Sanson is prepared for the welcoming of our children to St. Mark School. We know this will be another great year for our children and their parents. Also, our Sister Sonia, IHM, is preparing with her staff for our children in our PREP/CCD program, which is another great experience for our children and their parents.

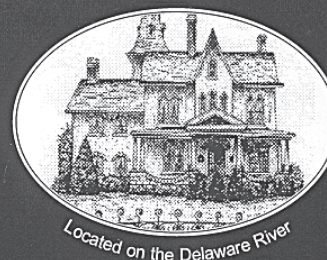

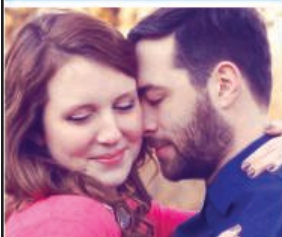
