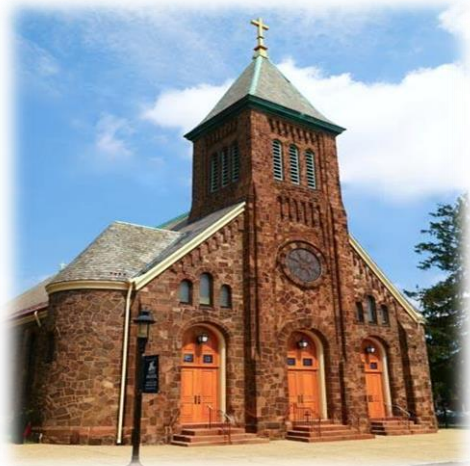
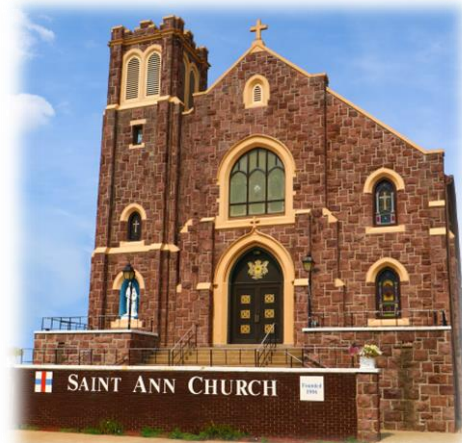

The Transfiguration of the Lord



My Dear Friends,

The Transfiguration is a one-time event in the life of Jesus, so different and unique that all three Gospels speak of it. I think that the Transfiguration happened to help the faith of the Apostles as well as to strengthen Jesus' faithfulness to the mission of his suffering in the passion and the cross which was soon approaching. Today, the Church offers us to join the three disciples as they walk with Jesus up that mountain. Jesus gives his disciples and us a glimpse of his identity; **"This is my beloved Son □ listen to Him."** □ In Jesus, you and I have a Father who cares and a Father who keeps his promises. This day in history on August 6, 1945, the Atomic Bomb was dropped on Hiroshima, Japan. There was a brilliant light which would change the attitude and minds from the fear of such destruction. Pope John Paul II on his visit to Hiroshima said: **"In the past it was possible to destroy a village, a town, a region, even a country. Now the whole planet has come under threat."** □ The Transfiguration of Jesus was a glimpse of glory, life, and salvation. But the transfiguration of the A-Bomb, the work of man, introduced and would bring fear, destruction, and darkness without life. Let us pray we will never experience such a terrible event again.

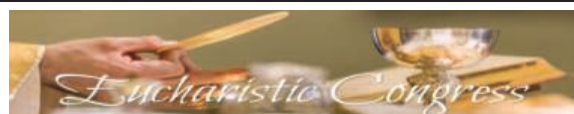
Tuesday, August 22nd, 2023

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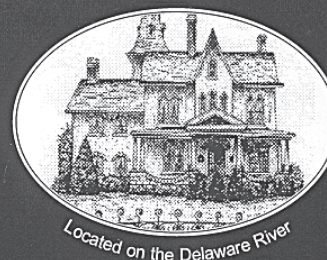
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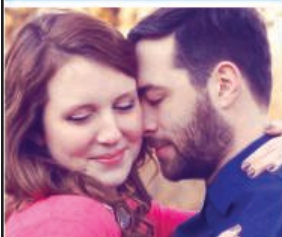
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
