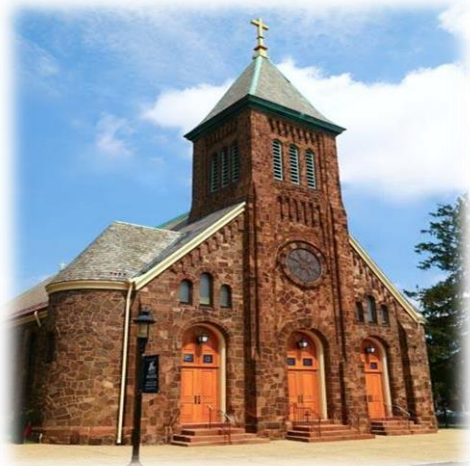
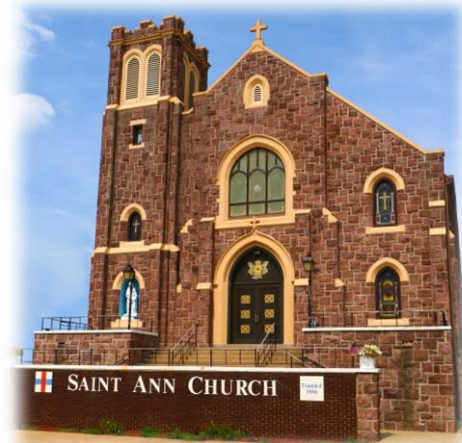

Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time



My Dear Friends,

Our Gospel from Matthew today presents the parable of the Sower. We know that the seed is the word of God and to help us understand the parable Father Guerric De Dona, OSN, has a beautiful reflection, and writes; *“The sower goes out to sow the seed, and it goes where it will and grows as it will. The conditions of the places where the seed falls is well known ☐ the path, rocky ground, thorns, and rich soil. I find it intriguing that there is not only a variety of destinies for the seed, but that good soil represents only a fraction of the places where the seed lands and flourishes. That should tell us something about how Jesus understands the way God sows and we listen: evidently, God sows lavishly and far reaching, but we listen to what we want to hear. Those who do take in the word deeply will nurture what has been sown, and it will produce fruit, a hundred or sixty or thirtyfold.”* ☐ This reading today makes me think of the words of Isaiah in the Old Testament, he tells us, *“For just as from the heavens the rain and snow come down and do not return there till they have watered the earth, making it fertile and fruitful, giving seed to him who sows and bread to him who eats, so shall my word be that goes forth from my mouth, it shall not return to me void, but shall do my will, achieving the end for which I sent it.”* ☐ Our hope and message today is that the word of God takes root in us and produces holiness and good works.

This weekend is the “Mission Cooperative Plan Collection.” We welcome Father Vimal Arokia Raj who is at this time staying at St. Ephrem Parish in Bensalem. We will use the envelopes in a Second Collection this weekend. I know that many of you have already made a donation and we thank you for your generosity to the missions. We will give a final report in next week's bulletin.

Getting ready for the upcoming Novena to Good St. Ann, which will begin on Tuesday, July 18th at 7:00 pm. Bishop Edward Deliman will offer the opening Mass and devotion that night. A number of priests from the area will be with us during these nights. Hope to see you there!

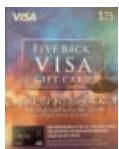

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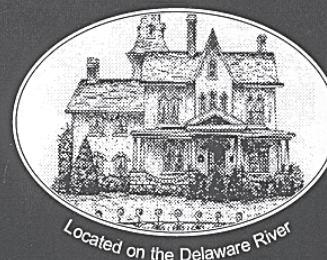

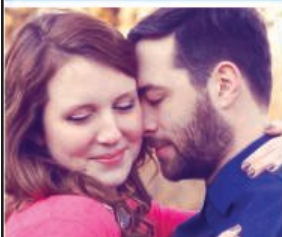
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
