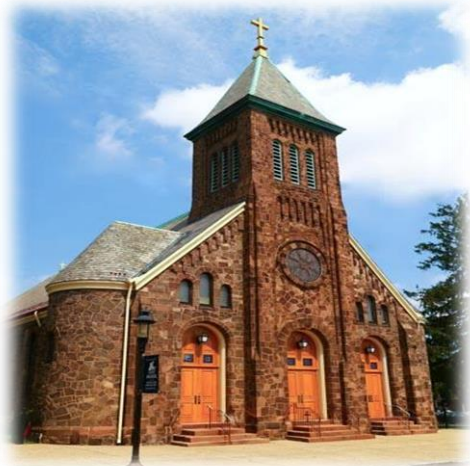
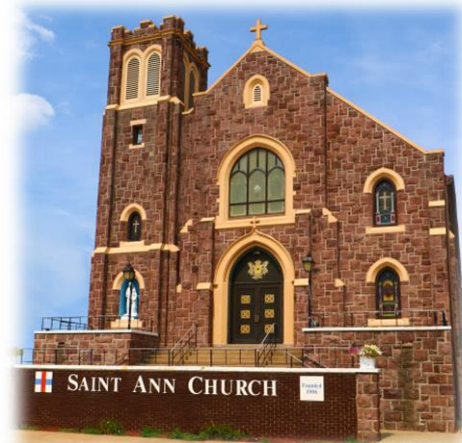

Sixteenth Sunday In Ordinary Time



My Dear Friends,

Today in the Gospel from Matthew, we hear a number of parables dealing with the Kingdom of Heaven. Jesus tells us the Kingdom can be like the seed that grows secretly, or a mustard seed, and like yeast in the flour. All point to the rhythm of growth and patience. All these images point also to the ways in our daily lives in which God's power and presence are with us. Jesus calls us to see this in our works and know that our failures and sinfulness are not the final word. These Kingdom parables of Jesus are not simply Jesus' teachings about the kingdom, but they are to be our experiences of the kingdom and God's presence. We must experience the growth and change many times so slow and painful, and have patience. Don't give up if there are no immediate results from prayer. It is also an opportunity for us to learn greater patience. Maybe this final thought; weeds require no labor. Gardening requires time and patience.

Just a quote from Father Mark Link, SJ, *"The wheat stands for good people, the weeds stand for evil people. Jesus' parable reminds me that I should not be disturbed to find weeds growing amid the wheat in Jesus' Church."* Also a quote from St. John Paul the Second; *"Be patient with the Church. It is always a community of weak and imperfect individuals. Put yourself at the disposal of the Church. The Church needs you. You are the future of the Church."* To the youth of Switzerland.

Our thanks to Father Vimal Arokiaraj from Kerala, India for his presentation on the Missions of our Church in India. Thank you for your generous contributions to the Missions of our Church throughout the world.

Well our Good Saint Ann Novena is going on this week and we pray that many of our requests for her intercession will be heard and answered by Jesus.

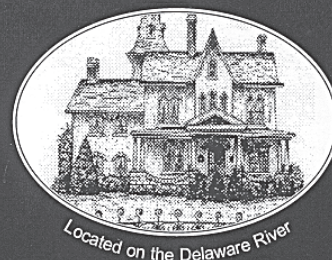
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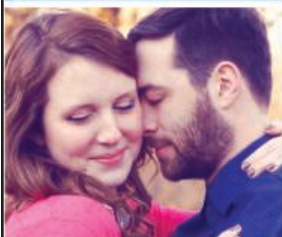
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
