My Dear Friends,

This Sunday, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. Father Richard DeLillio, OSFS, reminds us of the story about St. Patrick and the Trinity. Father writes: *"Folklore credits St. Patrick was using the three-leafed shamrock to explain the concept of the Holy Trinity, The Father, Son and Holy Spirit. He did this to help teach the non-Christian Irish during his missionary work in the fifth century. This fact is a bit more likely to be true than the mythic tale that he drove every snake from Ireland."* He goes on to write: *"Today's readings make it dramatically clear that the Sign of the Cross identifies God as Father, Son and Spirit, and us. This God is not to be feared, but to be embraced. Life doesn't end with the Trinity, it begins with it. That's the beauty of our God, and shows the difference from all other gods. It shows that we are baptized in the name of this Triune God. This is why any act of goodness or kindness is immeasurable in its effects on others, simply because it leads to perfection. God's trademark."* Each time we touch the Holy Water and bless ourselves in the name of the Trinity, we recall our Baptism and how the Holy Spirit descended on each of us and opened the way to eternal life. We became the beloved sons and daughters of our heavenly Father.

We had a nice turnout to honor our brave men and women on Memorial Day here at our Historic St. Mark Cemetery. Let us never forget the sacrifices, even to the point of offering their lives to ensure our freedom and liberty.

Summer Bridge Program

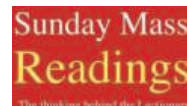

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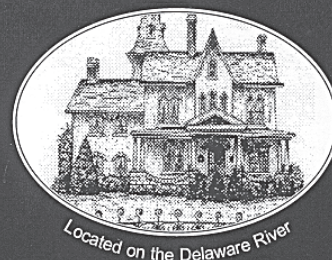
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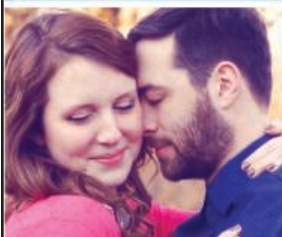
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
