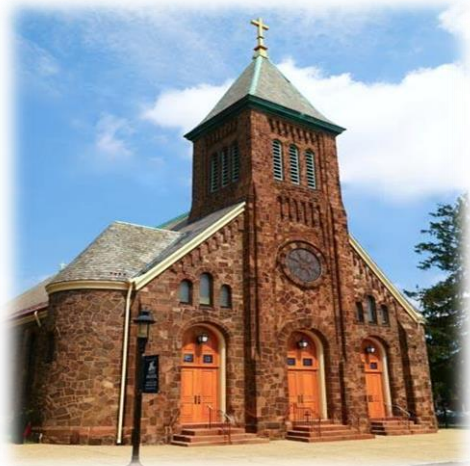
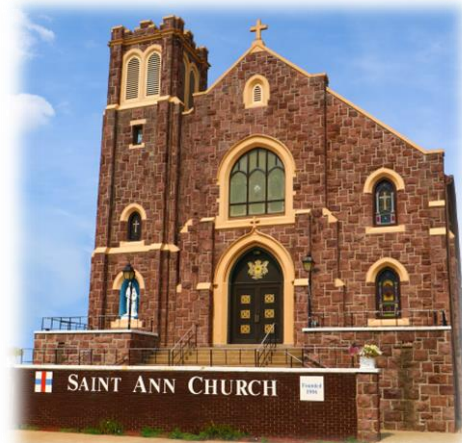

Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time



My Dear Friends,

To understand our gospel reading today, we need to remember or recall last Sunday's Gospel of Matthew. Crowds of people came to Jesus to hear him and to be healed by him. Jesus could hardly keep up with tending to the people's needs. He decided it was time to put his Apostles to work. The word Apostle means, one who has been sent. Jesus' instructions included working miracles, like healing the sick and casting out demons. They were to bring peace to those who were open to the message of Jesus. Today our Gospel is about love and loyalty to one's family, which was one of the most sacred bonds in the time of Jesus. Jesus tells his apostles they must not let their families get in the way of their mission and doing the works of the Lord. Jesus tells them, *"Whoever loves father or mother, son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me."* What Jesus is telling us is whoever places his relationship with God above all things, even life itself, will be greatly blessed with an abundance of life and joy.

I found this quote can calm me and many of my anxieties.

Reading II: Romans 6:3-4, 8-11

The baptismal ritual represents the death, burial and resurrection of Christ. The convert to the Faith emerges as a new person, now living *"for God in Christ Jesus."*

The Gospel: Matthew 10: 37-42

Whoever receives an Apostle receives Christ. He insists that we take up our individual cross and follow Him, showing care for the needy as did the Shunammite woman.

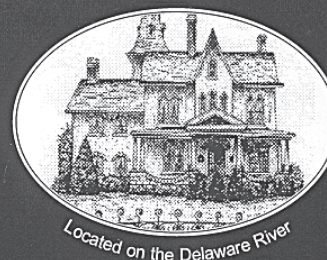

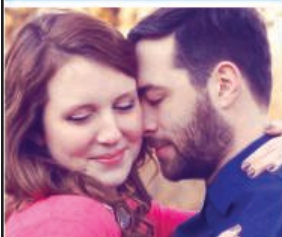
