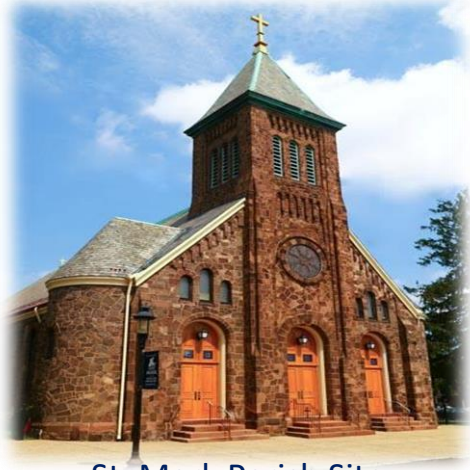
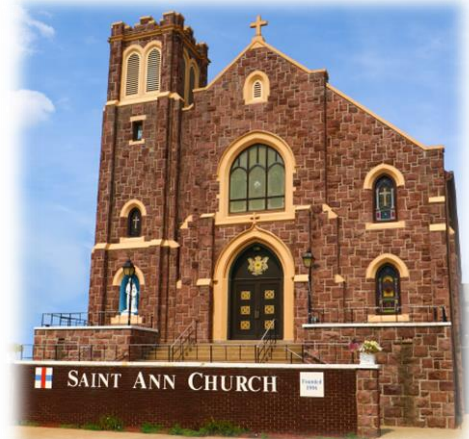

My Dear Friends,

Our Gospel from Matthew seems to be an invitation to us to lay down our burdens and come to rest with the one who is meek and humble of heart. Christ tells us that his yoke is easy and his burden light. The challenge for us is to know the Son the way the Father has revealed him to us. Jesus didn't say he would remove all burdens and difficulties from our lives but will be with us to assist and help carry our sufferings and burdens. Many people who are suffering from the death and loss of a loved one choose this Gospel for the Funeral Mass. This is a quote from St. Francis de Sales which reads; *"Do not look forward to the changes and chances of this life with fear, rather look to them with full confidence as they arise.
