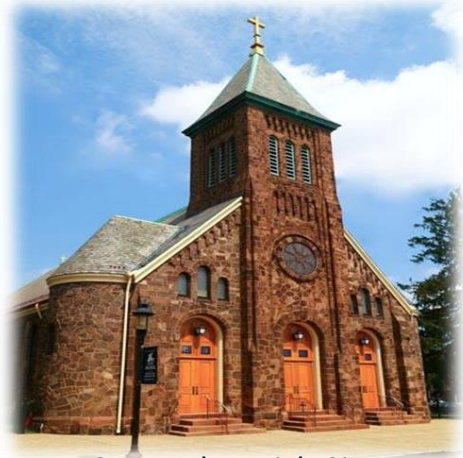
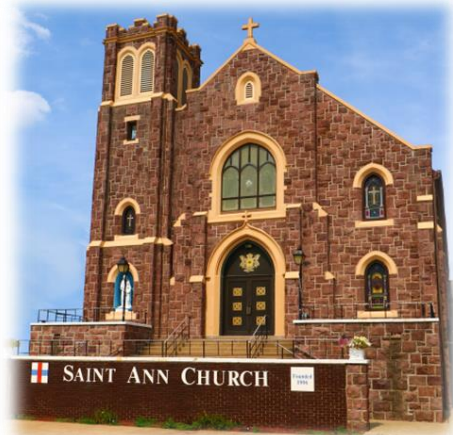

Thirtieth Sunday in Ordinary Time



My Dear Friends,

In our Gospel today, Jesus shares the Gospel of the Greatest Commandment. Here is a brief commentary on this Gospel from Father Richard R. De Lillo, OSFS, he writes: *"It has been said, 'Love works for those who work at it.' Our readings today are telling us the same thing...we must work at it, put it together little by little, day by day, and piece by piece, because love just doesn't happen."* This reminds me of a song by the Beatles in 1967, "All You Need is Love." Further back a song by Perry Como, "Love Makes the World Go Round." Many times at Wedding Celebrations, I make references to three kinds of love found in the New Testament of the Bible. There are three Greek Words that express love: EROS, based on romantic, erotic love, PHILIA love of friendship and shared interest (the name Philadelphia is derived from this love – brotherly love), and AGAPE, a Christ-centered and other-oriented, a self-giving and sacrificial love for the other. I tell those who are getting married all three should be present in their marriage. Living out this love, it may be easier to love the God we do not see and ignore our brothers and sisters we do see. This takes a lot of work and God's help and grace.

Our thanks to all who made our Annual Blue Mass a great and memorable experience. A time to honor our heroes and remember those who gave all to safeguard us. May God continue to shower His protection on them. God bless all our First Responders.

We will be celebrating All Saints Day and All Souls Day on the First and Second of November. Each year we remember our beloved deceased in our Parish Family. On November 1st, at the 6:30 pm Mass, we have invited family members of the deceased from this past year to bring a candle to the St. Joseph Altar to remember the spirit of our loved ones who still live, still guide, and lead us in this world.

LIHEAP & Property Tax/ Rent Rebate

This parish provides complimentary social work services to parishioners age 60 years and older by offering guidance, support, and practical solutions to promote dignity and independence. Low income Home Energy Assistance Program LIHEAP offers cash and crisis grants for households that fall at or below 150% federal poverty income guidelines.

Household Size	Income Limit
1	\$21,870.00
2	\$29,580.00
3	\$37,290.00
4	\$45,000.00

These grants can range from \$300 to \$1000.00 based on household size, income, and fuel type. The season opens for new applications November 1, 2023 and ends April 4, 2023.



The rebate program benefits eligible Pennsylvanians age 65 and older; widows, and widowers age 50 and older; and people with disabilities age 18 and older.

The income limit is \$35,000 a year for homeowners and \$15,000 annually for renters, and half of Social Security income is excluded. The maximum standard rebate is \$650.00, but supplemental rebates for qualifying homeowners can boost rebates to \$975.00. Application deadline is December 31, 2023. 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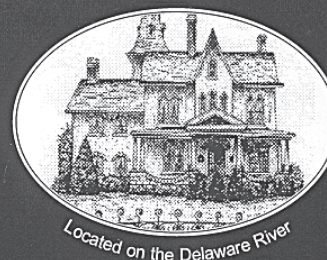
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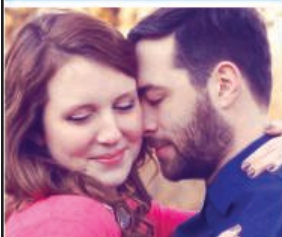
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
