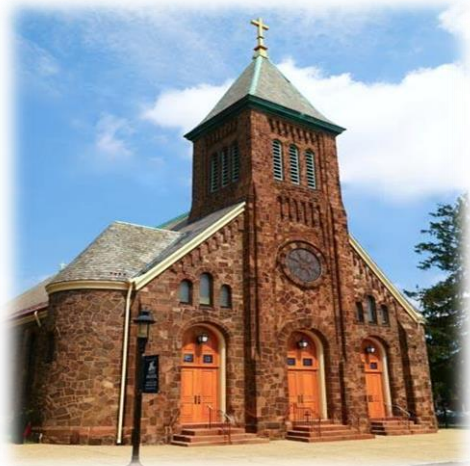
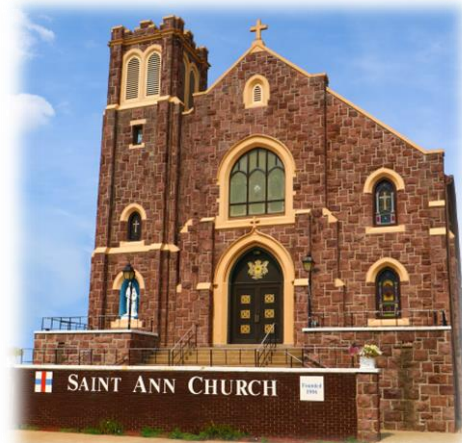

Twenty-Third Sunday in Ordinary Time



My Dear Friends,

Our Gospel from Matthew today is called by Father Guerric DeBona, OSB, *"The Work of Reconciliation."* He writes; *"The readings today navigate the hearer very clearly toward the waters of conversion with a ship of fellow Christians. At the center of changing our ways of repenting from evil and doing good invariably rests a desire to move closer to the living God. In human terms, that means being accountable to the Lord and one another."* Our readings also speak to us about sin. In our society today, we seldom hear about sin. We know that when we do sin, we hurt ourselves for we are doing something wrong and it takes us further away from God. But it is not just ourselves we hurt when we sin. Most of the time our actions hurt others as well. There seems also to be no objective truths in our world and only subjective truths, in other words, each person can determine what is good and evil for themselves. We like to think we are in charge and we can do what we want, with our bodies, our activities, Facebook, and with our time and our possession. We forget that we are not as much in charge as we would like to think. Today, Jesus offers us some suggestions about how to deal with sin, but I would warn you to be careful of becoming self-righteous. Seeing the speck in our brother's and sister's eyes and missing the plank in our own eye. We may be more concerned with others behavior and the lack of spirituality and not concentrating on our own relationship with God. Remember the words of Our Father, *"Forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us."*

We welcome back our children and our teachers to St. Mark School this September. I am sure our children are anxious to get back after a long rest this summer. We hope and pray this will be a great time of learning and growth for the children of St. Mark School. *"The Best in Bucks County."*

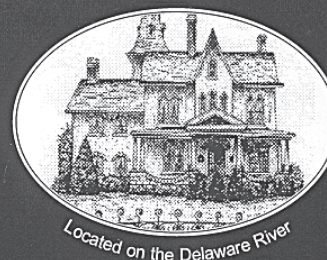

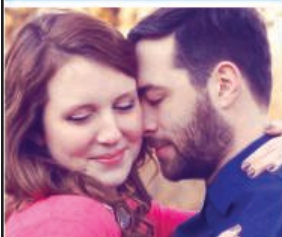
